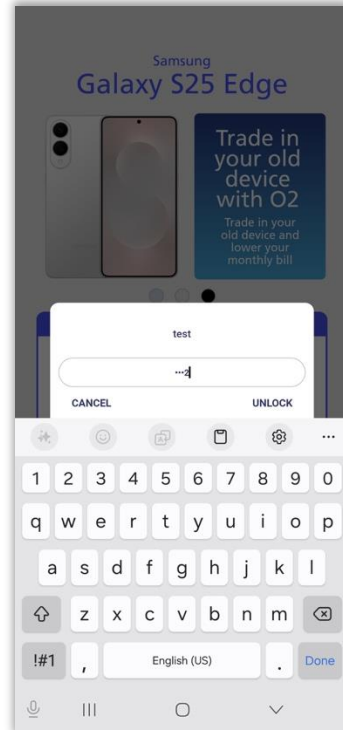


The update from O2 Pricing 1.3n to 2.02 requires a manual process on Samsung devices

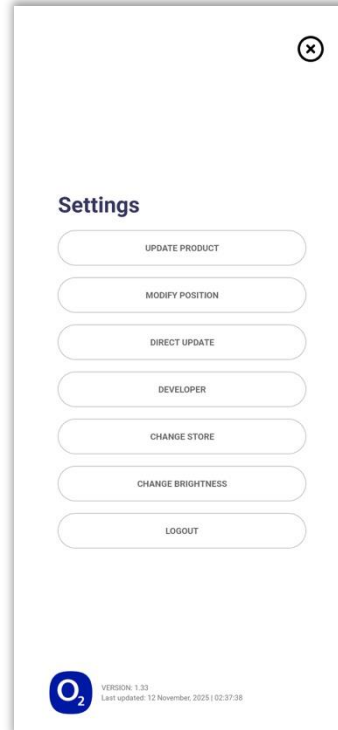
## LOGOUT



Open O2 Pricing and tap the screen with three fingers



Enter the password **o2o2** and tap unlock



Tap **LOGOUT**



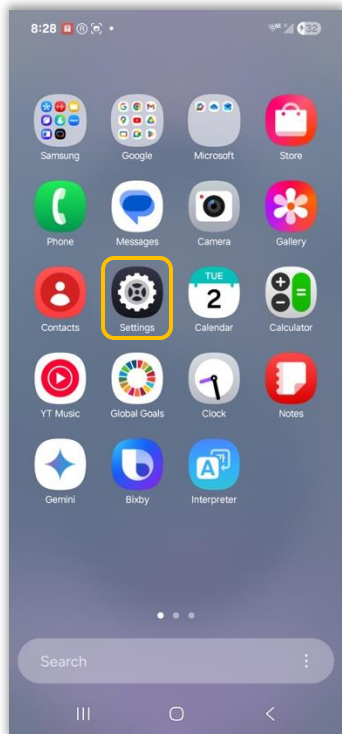
Confirm on the popup

# O2 Pricing Update | Verify Location is Enabled

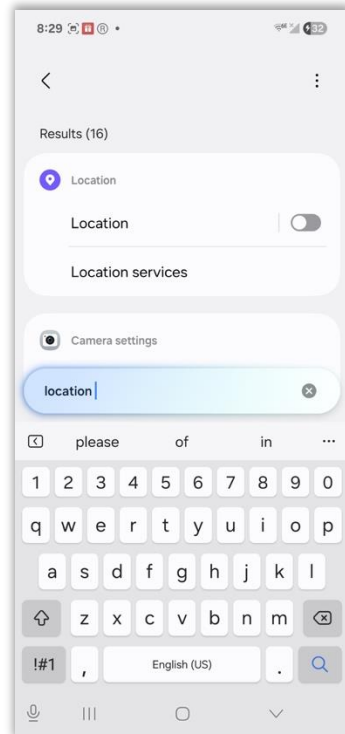
The app update requires location to automatically assign your device to your store



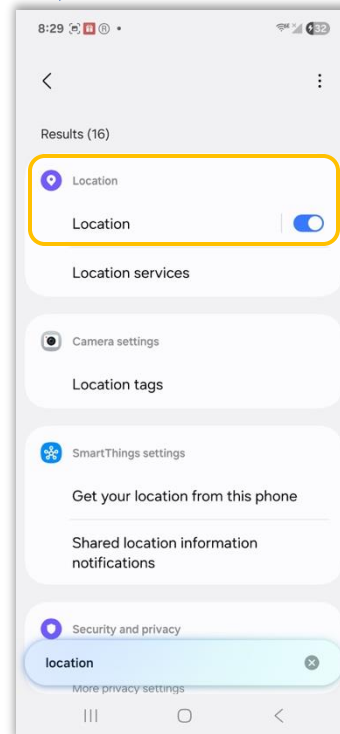
## LOCATION



Open the app drawer and tap **Settings**

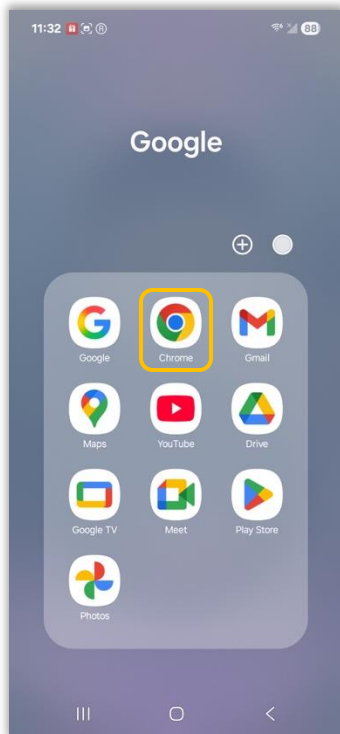


Search for **Location**. If it is already on, return to the home screen

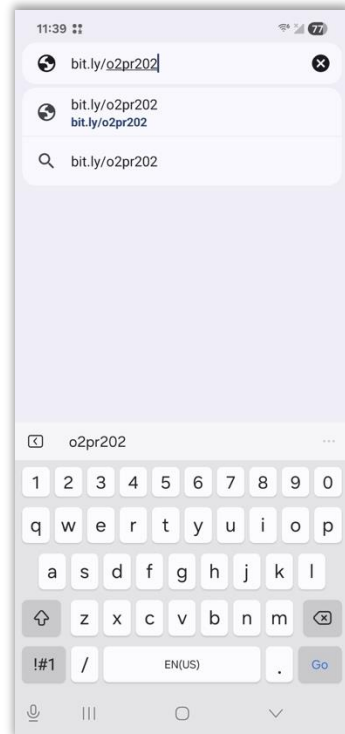


Otherwise, toggle on and return to the home screen

## DOWNLOAD

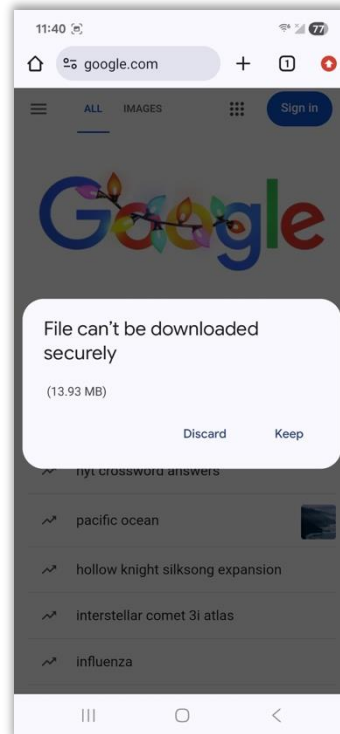


Open the app drawer, the Google folder, and tap **Chrome**



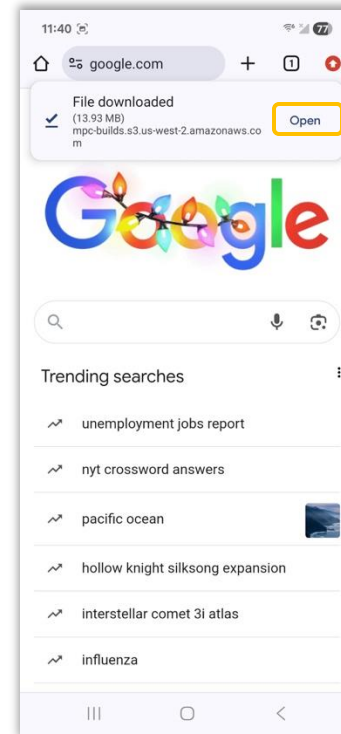
Tap the address bar at the top and go to:

**bit.ly/o2pr202**

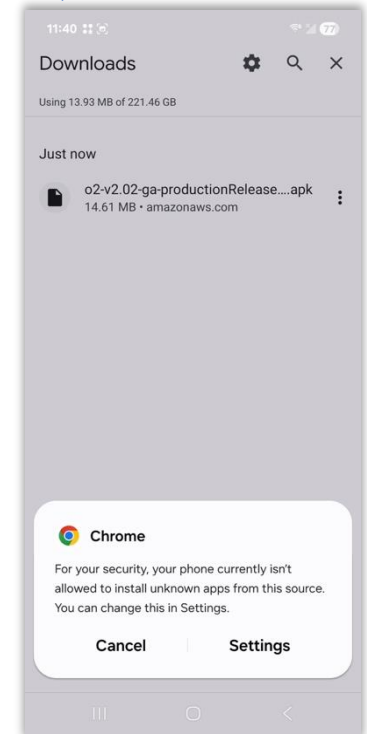


Tap **Keep**, if prompted\*

Tap **Open** in the popup



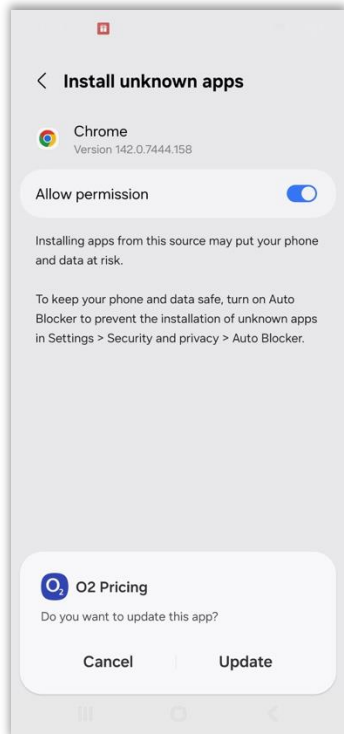
You may be asked to grant permission for Chrome to install.

Tap **Settings**

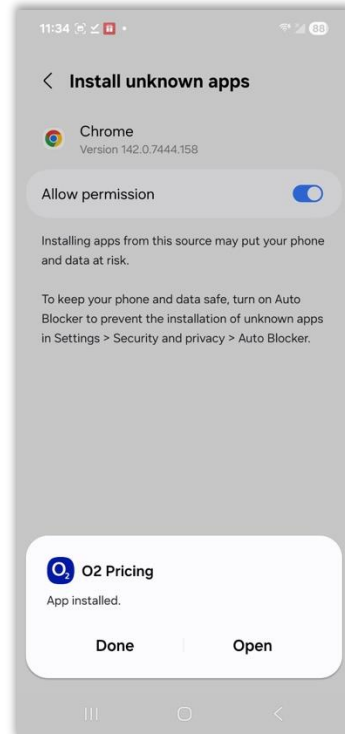

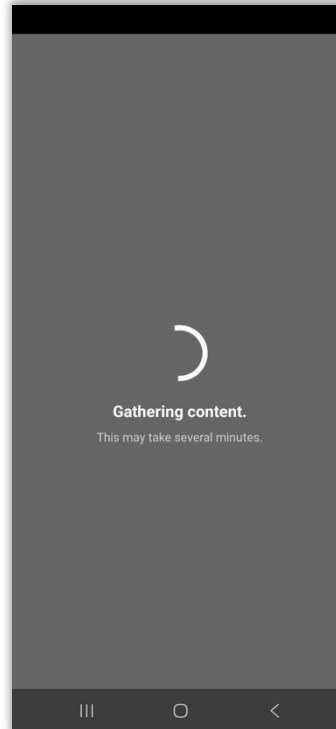
## INSTALL



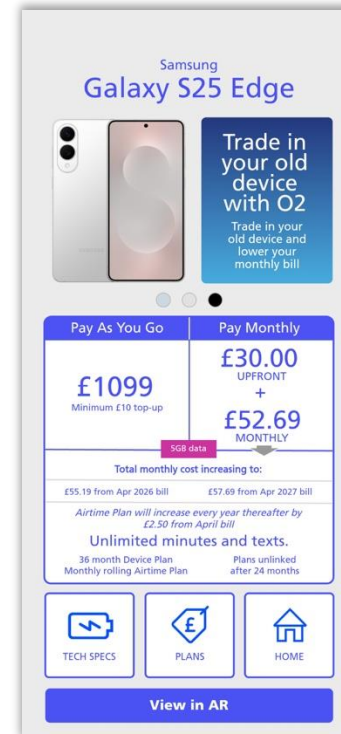
Toggle on **Allow permission**, then tap **Update** on the popup



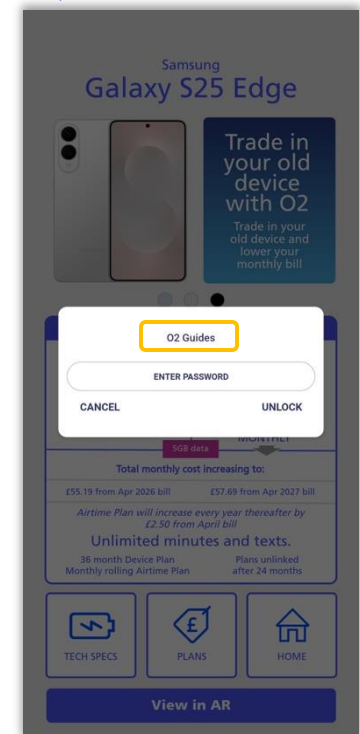
Tap **Open**
